Language Arts

- We're working on fiction and learning about characters.
- Readers notice how authors and illustrators portray how people are different.
- Readers use the meaning of text to inform how their reading should sound
- Readers notice patterns in text and use them to predict.
- We're writing and drawing stories with characters and settings.
- Writers communicate across pages in both pictures and words.
- We're learning about words and letters.
