	<p>Read a book and ask key questions:</p> <p>How are the characters feeling in your story?</p> <p>Do you see any letters you know in this book?</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of what you read today?</p> <p>Can you tell me about the story you drew today?</p>

<p>Reading – Learning about characters and their feelings in stories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Letters and the sounds they make • Using patterns to help ourselves read and understand stories <p>Writing - Drawing and writing stories with characters and settings</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have your child sort the laundry, their toys, or grocery items. Ask, “How did you sort them?” • Have your child count the number of items in each group they sorted or count the number of steps you take from one place to another • What numbers can you see? This could be asked when looking out the window on a drive or in a store.
